Am I getting what I paid for?

You've spent endless hours researching the perfect ring and finally bought a beautiful jewel online. But how do you know that the quality stated by the vendor is what you actually received? Especially if the ring was purchased from a vendor based overseas and is not subject to Australian Consumer Law.

The answer is to obtain an independent jewellery valuation. The valuation will confirm metal type and caratage, item weight, gemstone identity, size and quality.

It's important to remember that even though the vendor may issue you with an 'in-house' valuation certificate or a 'Certificate of Authenticity', it's still important to have the item checked over by a professional and valued for replacement in the Australian marketplace. This is especially crucial if the vendor has offered a specific return period for a potential refund if you are unhappy with your purchase.
